Physician Bio

Dr. Pachelli is a board-certified orthopedic surgeon. His practice focuses on disorders of the shoulder and knee. He received his medical degree at the University of New Mexico in 1981. He completed an internship in internal medicine in 1982 at Wesley Medical Center in Wichita, Kansas, and an orthopedic surgery residency at the University of Kansas St. Francis Regional

Medical Center and the Shriners Hospital for Crippled Children in St Louis. He completed a fellowship in arthroscopy of the shoulder and knee and athletic medicine at the Southern California Orthopaedic Institute in Van Nuys, Calif., in 1988. A fellowship is the highest level of training available for any specialized physician in the U.S. He received his certification from the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery in 1990. He was recertified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery in 1999. He is a member of the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons and the Arthroscopy Association of North America. He maintains active staff appointments at the New Mexico Orthopedic Surgery Center and Presbyterian



Hospital system. On several occasions, Dr. Pachelli has also served as a team physician for the United States Ski Team.
