Board-Certified Orthopaedic Surgeon

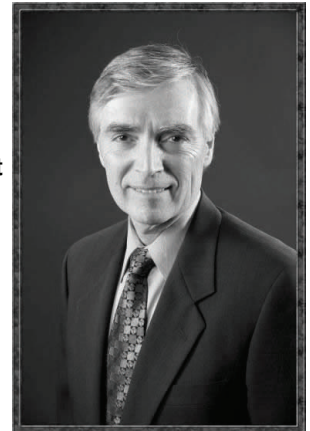
